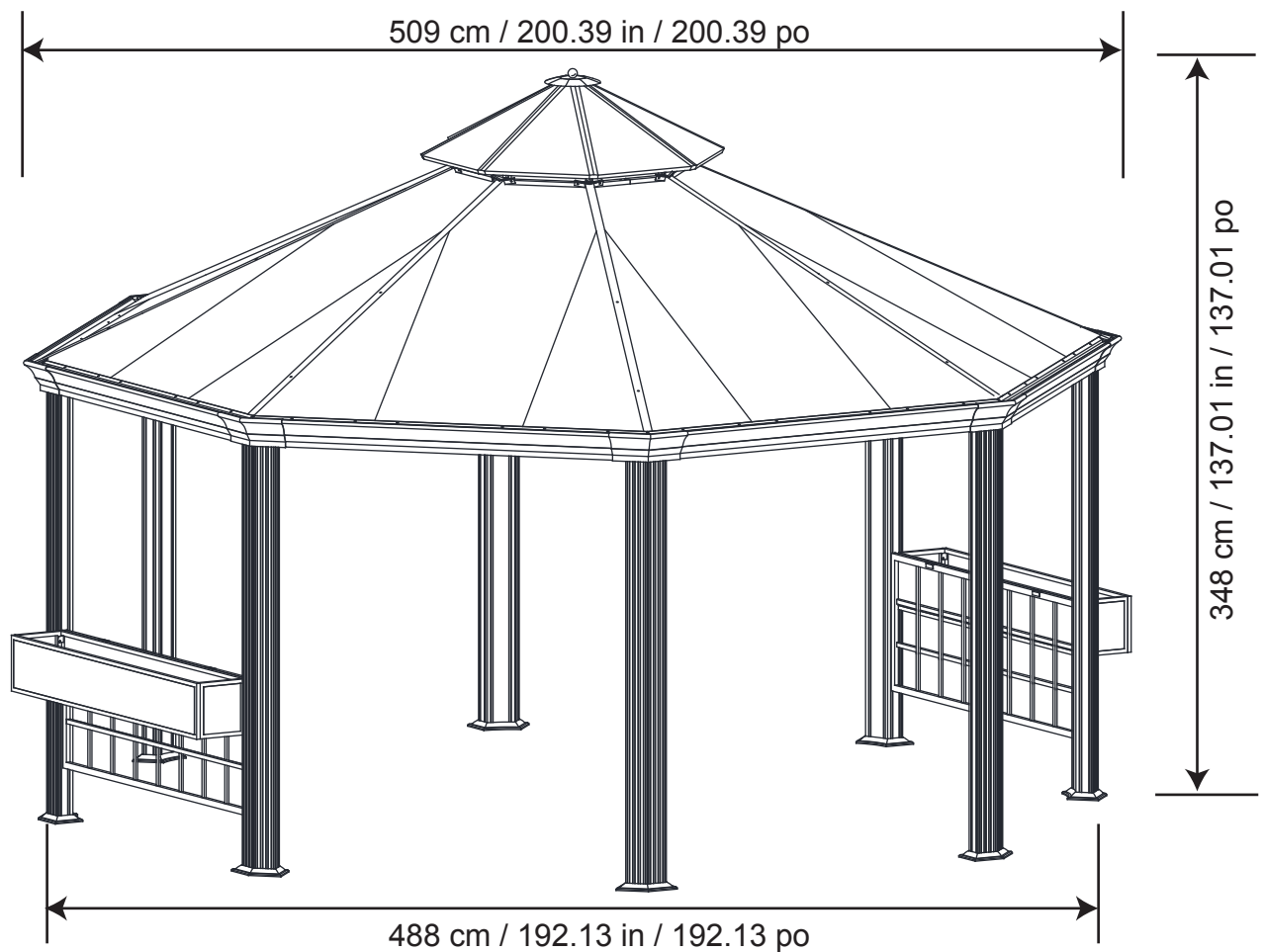

The fabric may burn if left in continuous contact with any flame source. The application of any foreign substance to the tent fabric may cause the flame-resistant properties ineffective.
- In the case of any high winds or high amounts of rain/snow, please remove the mosquito net, clear the snow from the roof immediately and check for damage before continuing use.

### CAUTION

#### SET UP YOUR GAZEBO PROPERLY

- This product is heavy so do not attempt to assemble this item alone. For the best and safest assembly experience, we recommend four (4) adults.
- Keep all children, pets and other obstructions away from assembly area.
- If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble the product.
- In order to avoid damage to the gazebo and it's components, please use the appropriate tools.
- Do not use the structure as support.
- Check all bolts on a regular basis to maintain the sturdiness and safety of the structure.
- Keep instruction manual for future use.
- Do not climb on top of the gazebo. Falling off the gazebo can result in serious injury, possibly even death.

#### EXAMINE YOUR GAZEBO

- Examine occasionally to ensure there are no loose parts.
- If loose parts are found, they should be retightened immediately.

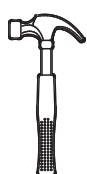
## PREPARATION

1.1 Put the Base Cover (K) onto the Pole (A1/A2/B), attach the Pole(A1/A2/B) to the Base (J) with Bolt (AA), see Fig.1.

1.2 Attach the Top Connector (D) to the Pole (A1/A2/B) with Bolt (AA), see Fig.2.

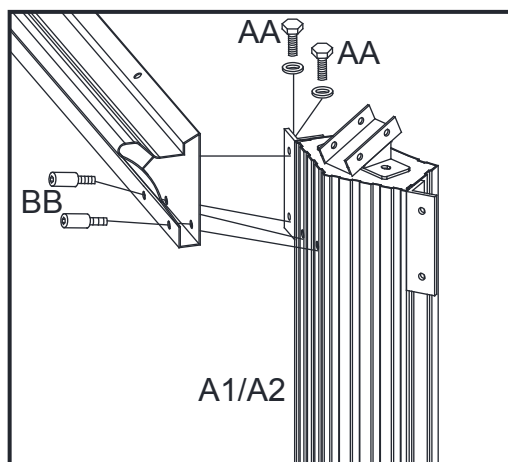

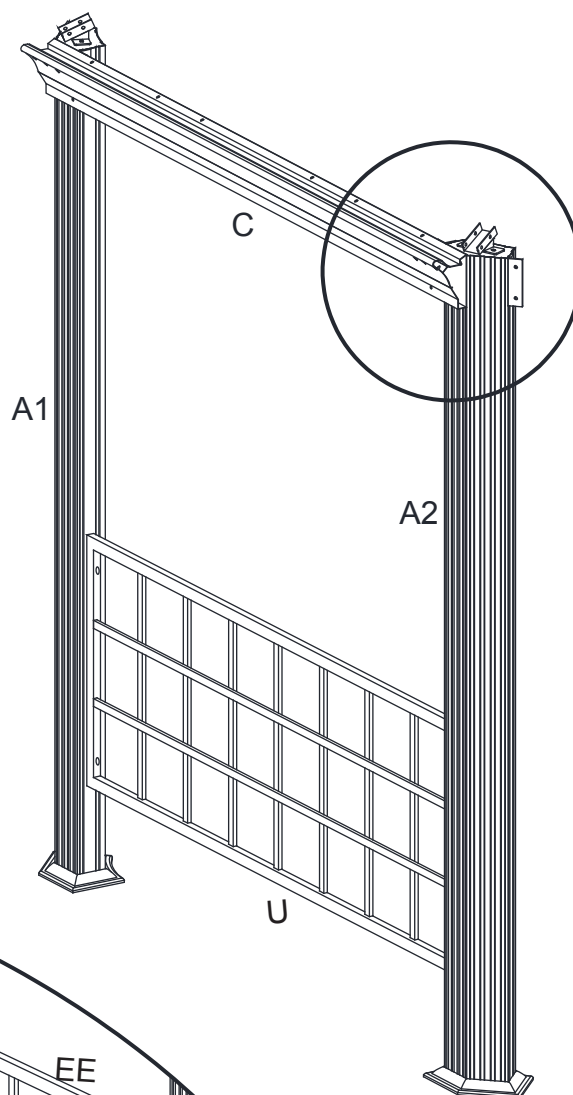
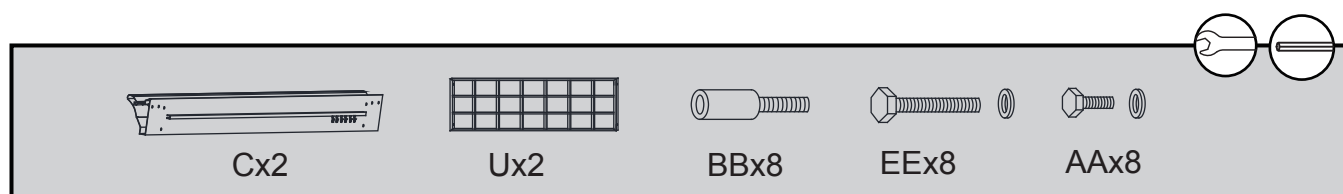

2.1 Attach the Enclosure (U) to the Pole (A1/A2) with Bolt (EE), see Fig.3.

2.2 Attach the Lintel (C) to the Pole (A1/A2) with Bolt (BB). Attach the Lintel (C) to the Pole (A1/A2) with Bolt (AA), see Fig.4.

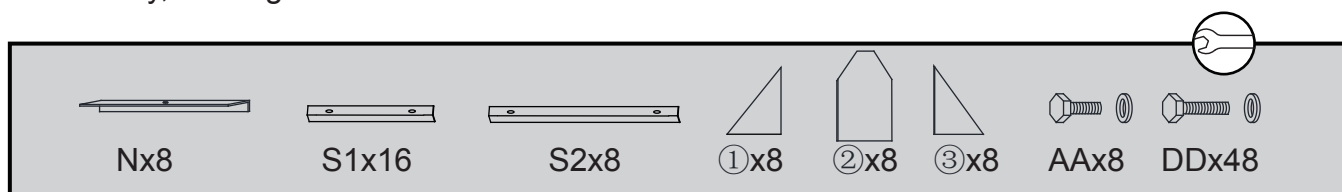




## Step 12



- 12.1 Install the big top panels in order as shown in the diagram, fix the big top panel onto the lintel (C) through the Short Trim Strip/Long Trim Strip (S1/S2) with Bolts (DD), see Fig.18.
- 12.2 Fix the Connector (N) onto the Roof Ring (F) with Bolts (AA), then connect the other side in the same way, see Fig.19.

14.2 Attach the Baskets Accessories (T3) into the bottom side of the Baskets Accessories (T1/T2/T4), and then hang the whole basket onto the Enclosure(U), see Fig.22.

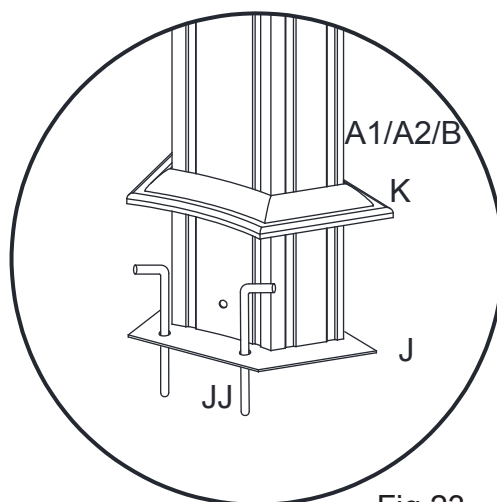
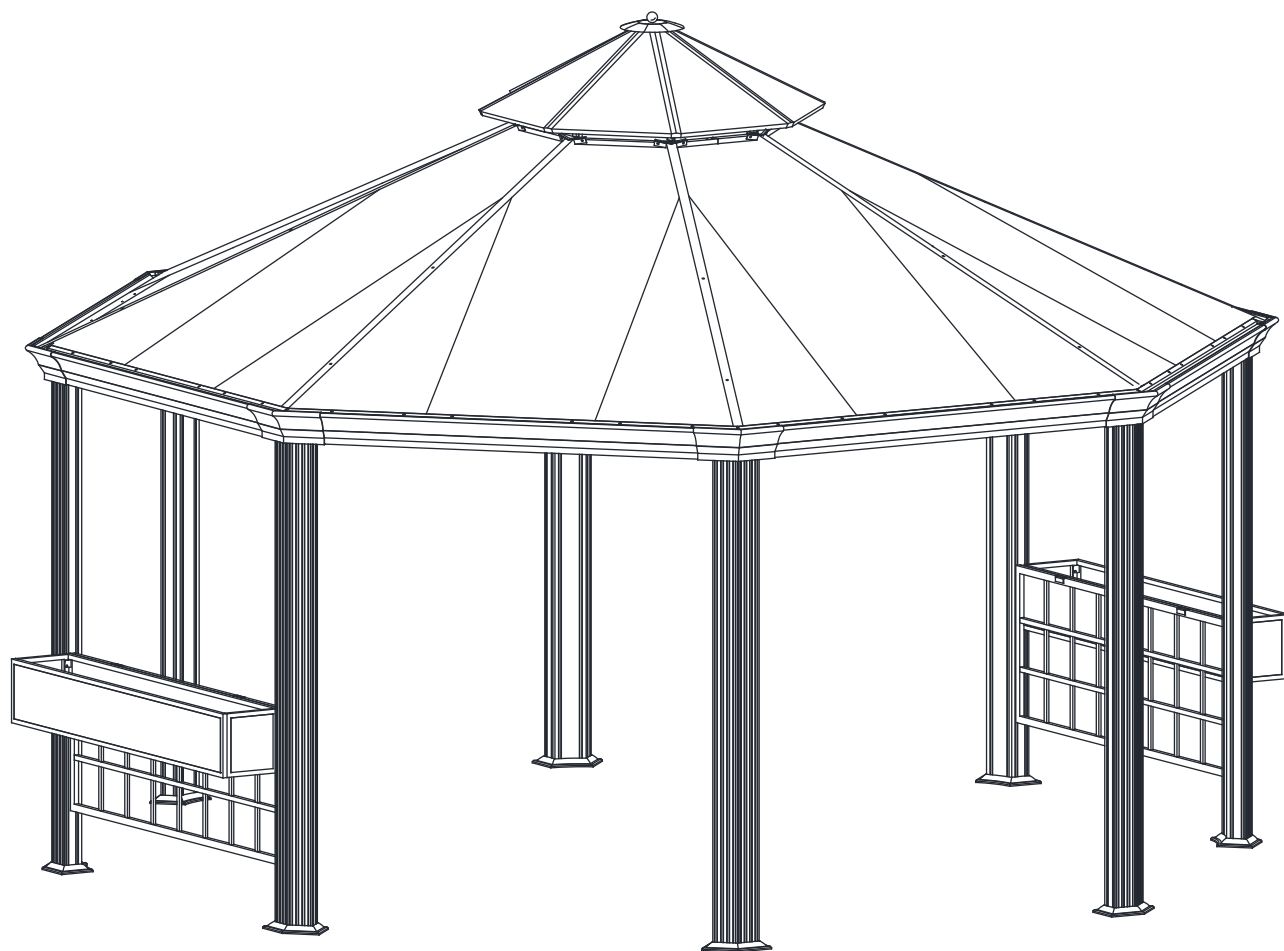
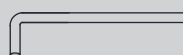

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

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- For cleaning, use a mild detergent solution, rinse with water, and allow to air dry. Do not use acetone, abrasive, or other special detergents as they would be harmful to the product's finish.
- Due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur if this protective coating is scratched. This is a natural process. To minimize this condition, it is recommended that care be taken when assembling and handling the product in order to prevent the paint from being scratched.
